Decades of Inaction Have a Human Cost

No new PTSD therapies since the 1990s. No new anxiety medications since 2007. The system hasn't changed but the suffering has grown. And, **it's costing lives, every single day.**

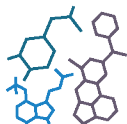
Psychedelic Treatments are Delivering New Hope

Prescription psychedelic treatments are showing promise of rapid, lasting results for Americans facing severe mental health challenges – offering a viable path to **reduce suffering and the national economic burden of mental illness.**

Condition	Treatment	Key Result
Generalized Anxiety Disorder	Deuterated DMT	67% showed response at 6 months ⁷
Alcohol Use Disorder	Psilocybin	48% reduction in heavy drinking days ⁸
Generalized Anxiety Disorder	LSD*	65% saw improvements in symptoms ⁹
Major Depressive Disorder	Bretisiloin	70% in remission by day 14; 94% by day 29 ¹⁰
Major Depressive Disorder	Deuterated Psilocin*	71% in remission at 12 months ¹¹
PTSD	MDMA*	67% of participants no longer met the diagnostic criteria for PTSD ¹²
Terminal Illness Anxiety	Psilocybin	60-80% report major relief ¹³
Treatment-Resistant Depression	5-MeO-DMT*	Ultra-rapid antidepressant effects by Day 1-7 ¹⁴
Treatment-Resistant Depression	Psilocybin*	37% had their depression cut in half or better at week 3 ¹⁵

- *Indicates **FDA Breakthrough Therapy** designation
- **Rapid and durable effects** - often after single administration
- Delivered in licensed, **supervised clinical settings**
- Showing signs of **low risk for abuse** but more study is needed

The Silent Struggle

- **17 veterans die by suicide** every day¹⁶
- **PTSD and depression remain under-treated**, despite widespread suffering
- **Current medication often fail** or worsen symptoms, and new solutions are long overdue

Challenge	Psychedelic Impact
Untreated PTSD	88% saw symptom relief with MDMA-assisted therapy ¹⁷
Delay or ineffective care	Relief in as little as 1-3 sessions ¹⁸
Risk of medication overload	Non-daily, supervised protocols reduce polypharmacy ¹⁹

Timing is Critical

There's been **no major PTSD treatment innovation in 35 years** – and failure to close this gap means continued suffering and rising suicide rates.²⁰

Over 500,000 veterans are currently treated by the VA, often with complex drug regimens and limited success.²¹

Psychedelic treatments show promise in enhancing VA care—and the difference between **rollout in 2-3 years vs. 5-10** could cost thousands of lives.
